Our primary goal with our tournaments is to bring together the Canadian trivia community for tournaments where players get the chance to play against each other in a fun, fair, and accessible environment. Gradwrite has been a labour of love for many of us, and we want you all to have a positive experience. As such, we expect players to be kind and respectful to each other and our staff, and to try to have fun!

We have **no tolerance** for any kind of hate, discrimination, bullying, harassment, cheating, or any inappropriate or aggressive behaviour. Consequences may include (but are not limited to) removal from the tournament if we deem it necessary.

Furthermore, for online tournaments, we ask all players to act with integrity and honour. Use of any aids that give you an unfair advantage are not permitted during gameplay, whether online or in your physical space. This includes searching for answers, having a poster visible in your room that gives information, etc. We also ask that cameras be on at all times during gameplay.

We do not expect any of these things to be any issue, but players should be aware of our expected conduct. Recognize that you are representing your team, your school, and the Canadian trivia community when you play.
